- An eminent scholar having a Ph.D. degree in the concerned/relevant discipline and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of publication work with, a minimum of 10 research publications in the peer-reviewed, NAAS rated or UGC-listed journal and a total API score of 120 as per the criteria given in Appendix -II and Table -2.
- A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in university/college as Assistant Professor*/Associate Professor and / or research experience at equivalent level at the University/National Level Institutions with evidence of having successfully guided doctoral candidate.

OR

- B.** An outstanding professional, having a Ph.D. degree in the relevant / allied / applied disciplines, from any academic institutions (not included in A above) / industry**, who has made significant contribution to the knowledge in the concerned / allied /relevant discipline, supported by documentary evidence provided he/she has ten years' experience.

Professor (S.No. F1 to F5)

- I) A recognized basic veterinary qualification included in the schedules I/II of Indian Veterinary Council Act; 1984 & must be registered with a State Veterinary Council/Veterinary Council of India.

2. In addition to above he/she should have published at least 10 research papers in the NAAS score of 6.00 or above or having impact factor (JCR Impact factor)

****Criteria for deciding an applicant from Industry as out-standing professional significant contribution.**

1. He/She should be member of the relevant professional society for last five years.
2. He/She should have at least two patents (granted) with commercialization in his/her credit.

Eligibility:

- i) A good academic record, with a Ph.D. Degree in the concerned/allied / relevant disciplines.
ii) A Master's Degree with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale, wherever the grading system is followed).
iii) A minimum of eight years of experience of teaching and / or research in an academic /research position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor (academic level 10 with rationalized entry pay of Rs.57,700/-) in a University, College or Accredited Research Institution/industry with a minimum of seven publications in the peer-reviewed, NAAS rated or UGC-listed journals and a total research score of Seventy five (75) as per the criteria given in Appendix -II and Table -2.

- c) Minimum of 8 years of experience in teaching/ research/ industry out of which at least 2 years shall be Post Ph.D. experience and a total research score of Seventy-five (75) as per the criteria given in Appendix -II and Table -2.

Assistant Professor (Sr. No. F6)

- I. A recognized basic veterinary qualification included in the schedules I/II of Indian Veterinary Council Act; 1984 & must be registered with a State Veterinary Council/Veterinary Council of India.

- i) A Master degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned/relevant/allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
 - ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC/CSIR/ICAR or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET :
Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions :-
 - a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;
 - b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
 - c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
 - d) The Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;
 - e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D. work in conferences/seminars/ sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC / ICSSR/ CSIR/ICAR or any similar agency.

The fulfillment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

Note: NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR and ICAR or similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET.

OR

- B. The Ph.D. degree has been obtained from a foreign university/institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following: (i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) (ii) the Times Higher Education (THE) or (iii) the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).

NOTE-

1. A relaxation of 5% shall be allowed at the Bachelor's as well as at the Master's level for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Other Backward Classes (OBC)(Non-creamy Layer)/Differently abled(a) Blindness and low vision; (b) Deaf and Hard of Hearing; (c) Loco motor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured, dwarfism, acid-attack victims and muscular dystrophy; (d) Autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness; (e) Multiple disabilities from amongst persons under (a) to (d)including deaf-blindness) for the purpose of eligibility and assessing good academic record for direct recruitment. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever the grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based only on the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedure.
2. A relaxation of 5% shall be provided, (from 55% to 50% of the marks) to the Ph.D. Degree holders who have obtained their Master's Degree prior to 19 September, 1991.
3. A relevant grade which is regarded as equivalent of 55% wherever the grading system is followed by a recognized university, at the Master's level shall also be considered valid.
4. The time taken by candidates to acquire M.Phil. and / or Ph.D. Degree shall not be considered as teaching/research experience to be claimed for appointment to the teaching positions. Further the period of active service spent on pursuing Research Degree simultaneously with teaching assignment without taking any kind of leave, shall be counted as teaching experience for the purpose of direct recruitment.

Note : The academic score as specified in (Table-3A) and written examination shall be considered for short listing of candidates for teaching skill test and interview, and the selections shall be based only on the performance in the teaching skill test and interview.

(ii) **Submission of printed copy of online filed application form**


7. Persons already in employment should upload No Objection Certificate (NOC) as per the format from the present Employer and send their application along with original No Objection Certificate (NOC). Without NOC their application will not be considered.
8. Reservation rule as per the State Government will be applicable. The claimant for reservation must furnish the certificate as applicable, issued by the competent authority of U.P. Govt. SC/ST/OBC/EWS/Persons with disability (PWD). The claimant for reservation of OBC and EWS are required to submitted the current year certificate as per the Performa of U.P. state Govt. The candidates belonging to EWS category are must required to produce the EWS certificate as per the prescribed Performa (प्रपत्र-1) of U.P. state Govt. by the order no. 3/2019/4/1/2002का-2/19टी.सी-II dated 14 March, 2019. The candidates belonging to OBC category are required to produce the OBC certificate as per the prescribed Performa (प्रपत्र-2) of U.P. state Govt.
9. The applicants who wish to apply for more than one post should submit separate application forms in separate envelopes accompanied by relevant enclosures and online application fee payment receipt for each post.
10. Applicants should clearly note that the university will, in no case be responsible for non receipt of their applications or any delay in receipt thereof on any account. Applications received after the due date shall stand rejected.
11. Maximum age limit for the post of Assistant Professor, shall be 40 years, relaxation of 05 years in case of OBC (Non-creamy Layer) and SC/ST category and 15 year relaxation for PWD. 05 years relaxation to the regular employee of State of UP as per शासनादेश संख्या-2-ई0एम0/2001-का-4-2013 दिनांक 27 अगस्त, 2013. However there is no upper age limit for these posts of Associate Professor and Professor.

12. Candidates are essentially required to be appeared in the domain knowledge examination. Without appearing in the domain knowledge examination their candidature will not be considered for short listing of candidates for interview for the post of Assistant Professor.



- (i) Paper in refereed journals without impact factor – 5 Points
- (ii) Paper with impact factor less than 1 – 10 Points
- (iii) Paper with impact factor between 1 and 2 – 15 Points
- (iv) Paper with impact factor between 2 and 5 – 20 Points
- (v) Paper with impact factor between 5 and 10 – 25 Points
- (vi) Paper with impact factor > 10 – 30 Points

(a) Two authors : 70% of total value of publication for each author.

(b) More than two authors : 70% of total value of publication for the First/Principal/Corresponding author and 30% of total value of publication for each of the joint authors.






Criteria for short listing of candidates for teaching skill test & interview:

1. The Scrutiny Committee will assess the marks of applicants in the Academic Score (Table-3A) on the basis of information provided by the candidate in the application.
2. The marks awarded in Academic Score (Table-3A) to the applicants will be published in the university website and objections will be invited. For raising objection, 07 days time will be provided. All objections will be received through an email ID recruitmentsvpuat2021@gmail.com. The objections received within the stipulated time will be resolved by the Scrutiny Committee and revised marks will be again published.
3. To test the domain knowledge, an objective type written examination of 40 marks will be conducted and the result will be declared by the university as soon as possible. Marks obtained by each candidate will be published on university website and objections if any, on the marks obtained will be invited in 03 days time. All objections will be received through email. The objections received within time will have to be resolved and revised marks will again be published.
4. A combined merit list will be prepared on the basis of marks obtained in Academic Score and written examination (A+B of Table-3A) by the University.

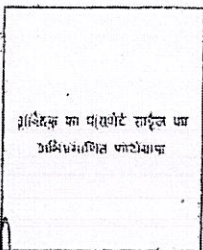


