At Hostel level wardens follow the regulations as per Academic regulations and maintain discipline.

- ➣ In case the cases are serious in nature the same are referred to chief warden/concerned Dean of the colleges.
- The matter is taken up in College Discipline board.
- The cases of more serious in nature or matter between two colleges are referred to University Discipline Committee consisting of Dean of the Colleges and DSW as Member Secretary.
- The Vice Chancellor on the recommendations of Discipline committee accord approval for punishments thereof.

Breach of Discipline and Punishment(s) there of

50 Acts of Indiscipline :

- (A) The following shall constitute acts of indiscipline:
 - (a) Keeping, carrying, using or supplying of any fire arms, lethal weapons, knife with a blade of more than four inches length in the room or outside.
 - (b) Keeping, using or supplying intoxicants in any form.
 - (c) Gambling in any form.
 - (d) Ragging, bullying or harassing of student(s).
 - (e) Demonstration in any form including procession and meeting.
 - (f) Strike or hunger strike.
 - (g) Bycotting of an University function, programme or activity preventing any student from attending classes, functions, programme or any other activity of the University.
 - (h) Abusing.
 - Recourse of violence, assault, intimidation, rioting.
 - (j) Showing or causing to show any disrespect to a teacher or officer or any misbehavior or intimidation of an employee of the University.
 - (k) Incitement to commit any act of indiscipline.
 - Any breach of law of the country or the state or the Statute, Regulation, Rules of the University or orders of a competent authority.
 - (m) Disturbing other students in their studies.
 - (n) Damaging any University property.
 - (o) Disorderly behavior in any form.
 - (p) Attending or organizing unauthorized meetings and participation in such meetings.
 - (q) Displaying notices, leaflets or posters not signed or countersigned by the Warden or other University officers authorized by the Vice-chancellor at the hostels and University notice boards or other places or distributing such notices or leaflets or disfiguring or defacing or writing slogans and undesirable things on the building, property etc.
 - (r) Any act specifically forbidden by the Warden, Chief Warden, Dean Student Welfare or any officer of the University.

Any other act intended or calculated to cause inconvenience, and to any other inmate of the hostel, employed Any other act intended to any other inmate of the hostel, employee injury or damage to any other ampus or guest visitors to the Line of injury or damage to any compus or guest visitors to the University or resident of the campus or guest visitors to the University

(B) Punishment for Indiscipline

- Any inmate who violates any to the warden/Instructor, if the Warden/Instructor; Warden/Incharge of the hostel/Instructor, if the Warden/Instructor is sas that the fine is adequate punishment for the act of indiscipline
- b) Cases of indiscipline, which in the opinion of the Warden/Instructor to Cases of indiscipline, the College would not be sufficient punishment she serious that a fine of Rs. 250/-or less would not be sufficient punishment she referred by the Warden to the Chief Warden/Dean of the College concerns taking disciplinary action against the inmate(s).
- The Chief-Warden/Dean on the recommendation of the Discipline Board of college may award any of the following punishments:-
 - (i) Fine upto Rs. 1000/-. This shall be noted on the inmate's permanent recard but shall not go out on the transcript.
 - (ii) Placing the inmate on 'Conduct Probation' on the recommendation College Discipline Board. This will consist of an official warning to students that one more incident of indiscipline might lead to the disme of the student from the University. It shall be noted on the inmo permanent record card and shall go out on the transcript of the studen long as the student is on such probation.
 - (iii) Reprimand of Record: This shall consist of an official warning to student not to repeat any act of indiscipline. This will be noted on stude permanent record card but not on any outgoing transcript.
- (d) Cases of more serious indiscipline in respect of which the Chief Warden/Dea satisfied that the forgoing punishment in clause 50 (2) above, would not adequate to meet the ends of justice and call for more severe punishment cases involving students of more than one college/hostel, shall be referred to Discipline committee by the Chief Warden or any other officer of the Univers coming across any acts of indiscipline to the Secretary of the Discipl Committee.
- The recommendations of the Discipline Committee shall be forwarded to Vice-chancellor as expeditiously as possible.
- (f) The Vice-chancellor after considering the recommendations of the Disciple Committee may award any one or more of the following punishments

- (i) Monetary Fine
- (ii) Collective or Group Fine: May be imposed on a group of students, as a whole, when the Vice-chancellor, on the recommendation of the Discipline Committee, is of the opinion that it is not possible to fix the responsibility on individual member of the group for any act of indiscipline.
- (iii) Reprimand on Record: This shall consist of an official warning to the student not to repeat any act of indiscipline. This will be noted on student's permanent record card but not on any out going transcript.
- (iv) Conduct Probation: This shall consist of an official warning that one more incident of indiscipline might lead to the dismissal of the student from the University. It shall be noted on the permanent record card and shall go out on the transcript so long as the student is on conduct probation.
- (v) Temporary Dismissal: The student shall be dismissed from the University for a specific semester(s) and required to leave the University campus immediately. This will be entered on the permanent record card and shall go out in transcript of the student if the same is issued during the period of temporary dismissal. It shall, however, not be mentioned in the outgoing transcript, in case the transcript is issued after re-admission. However, he/she shall be debarred from admission to the University for any further programme.
- (vi) Permanent Dismissal Rustication from University: The student shall be dismissed permanently from the University and shall be required to leave the University immediately. The punishment shall be entered in the permanent record card and transcript of the student and he shall be debarred from admission to the University for any further programme.

(C) Suspended Dismissal:

- (a) If a student has been awarded the punishment of temporary dismissal for one or more semesters and he has only two semesters or less to complete his degree then the punishment of temporary dismissal may be suspended on compassionate ground and he may be placed on 'Conduct Probation' by the Vice-chancellor to enable him to complete his degree on his moving an application duly countersigned by his parent/guardian and filling in a bond of good behavior with such conditions as may be imposed for the remaining period of his stay in the University.
- (b) In the case of permanent dismissal, if a student has completed at least two semesters satisfactorily in this University prior to being awarded the punishment of permanent dismissal may be suspended on compagnonate



- grounds and the student may be re-admitted on bond with such condition may be imposed of good behavior under this regulation.
- (c) Re-admission through suspension of punishment shall invariably be subject the following conditions:
 - The student concerned may be readmitted not as a matter of right but on compassionate ground on the submission of an unconditional apology
 - ii) The student concerned will remain on conduct probation during remaining period of his stay in the University.
 - iii) The student concerned will fill a bond of good behavior as prescribed to countersigned by his parent/guardian which would remain operative the entire period of his stay in the University.
 - iv) He will not apply nor will be entitled to admission to any new deprogramme in the University.
 - v) If the student concerned has been permanently dismissed he may considered to apply for relief under this regulation only after exping three semesters from the date of issue of orders of punishment but in case will be entitled to re-admission before the expiry of less than for semesters from the effective date of punishment.
 - vi) No student shall be eligible for seeking relief under this regulation unleads to his being awarded the punishment of permanent dismissal.
 - vii) No student shall be eligible to seek or be granted relief under to regulation if he commits any act of indiscipline in the University campus misbehaves with any officer or teacher of the University within the camp or outside during the period laid down in clause (v) above.
- (d) Before granting the extraordinary concession of Suspension of the permanent temporary dismissal the Vice-chancellor may follow any procedure that considers appropriate in order to ascertain as to whether the student applying the same is likely to abide by the rules and regulations of the University and not likely to himself indulge or instigate others to indulge in violation of Rules and Regulations. During the period of suspension of permanent /temporary dismissal, the daily attendance of the student concerned shall taken by the Warden /Asstt. Warden of the hostel and it shall be obligatory him to present himself before either of them when called upon to do so.
- (e) The Vice-chancellor may revoke the order of suspension of punishment his/her own initiative or on the receipt of a report from the Chief Warden/Do of the College concerned /Dean Student Welfare /Registrar to Tect that

student concerned has violated conditions of the bond which will in addition to any other specific conditions which may be enforced at Vice-chancellor's discretion, invariably require him not to:

- Absent himself from the hostel for two or more days consecutively without prior permission of the Warden /Chief Warden.
- ii) Boycott or absent himself from any examination without prior permission.
- iii) Fall below 75% in attendance in any of the course offered by him/her.
- Fail to present himself/herself before his/her Advisor, Warden, Chief Warden despite having been asked to do so.
- v) Commit any of indiscipline as defined.
- Fail to maintain a GPA of 5.500 in the case of under-graduate, 6.500 in the case of Master's and 7.250 in case of Ph.D. degree programme.
- However, while the benefit of this regulation may be available to cases of indiscipline where the punishment of temporary or permanent dismissal has been awarded for the first time, it is hereby laid down that (i) the suspension of temporary dismissal may be given to student only once during his stay in the University, (ii) if the orders of suspension of punishment of permanent dismissal have been revoked by the Vice-chancellor on his own or on receipt of a report from the Chief Warden/Dean of the College concerned/Dean Student Welfare Registrar to the effect that the student concerned has violated the conditions of the bond or other conditions imposed upon him at the time of re-admission, then such a student may apply for the review of revocation order only after the expiry of four semesters from the date of issue of revocation orders of suspended dismissal and may be readmitted on bond with such conditions as may be imposed of good behavior under the regulations and this re-admission, through review of revocation order of permanent dismissal shall invariably be subject to the same conditions as imposed earlier. In case such a student violates any conditions of the bond or other conditions imposed by the Vice-chancellor or involve in any act of indiscipline then the student shall be permanent with no right to appeal for re-admission.
- (g) The regulations shall also not apply in case a student is awarded the punishment of temporary dismissal for copying or to any student who is awarded the punishment of temporary or permanent dismissal and who after having been debarred from entering the campus is reported to be seen entering the campus without specific permission of the Vice-chancellor. If a student indulges in any act of indiscipline after completing the graduation requirement and or after obtaining the Provisional Degree Certificate, in such cases an F.I.R. will

- invariably be lodged with the police and his character certificate will be in only after the final decision.
- (h) The Advisor of the student concerned, Hostel Warden concerned may all invited by the College Discipline Board /Discipline Committee while enquirement into a disciplinary case.
- (i) A punished student may file a request for review of the decision within month from the date of issue of the order after which no review application, lie and only one review application can be filed.
- (j) Procedure for the Removal of Conduct Probation
- A The Dean of the College concerned may remove a student from the condeposition on the recommendation of the Advisor, Warden and if necessary, college discipline board in case he was not involved in acts of indiscipline may than once under the following conditions:-
 - If the student was placed on conduct probation by the Dean/Chief Ward on the recommendation of the College Discipline Board.
 - If the student was placed on conduct probation by the Vice-chancellor has completed the graduation requirements.
- B The Vice-chancellor may remove a student from the conduct probation on \$ 5 recommendation of the Discipline Committee under the following situations
 - If the student was placed on conduct probation by the Vice-chancellor the recommendation of the Discipline Committee;
 - If the student was placed on conduct probation either by the Dean/Chit 5
 Warden or by the Vice-chancellor and was involved in acts of indisciplin more than once.
- C The procedure for removal of Conduct Probation for the students temporarily dismissed or permanently dismissed but readmitted under regulation 50 (3) shall be as under:-
 - The Conduct Probation of students, temporarily dismissed once and for one semester may be removed by the Vice-chancellor on the recommendations of the Discipline Committee.
 - The conduct probation of students permanently dismissed but readmitted under regulation 50 (3) may be removed by the Academic Council on the recommendation of the Committee constituted by the Council.
 - 3) The Conduct Probation of students, temporarily dismissed more than once for two semesters or more may be removed by the Academic Council on the recommendation of the Discipline Committee.

NOTE:

The constitution of Academic Council's Sub-committee for removal of Conduct Probation and issuance of documents with good conduct or otherwise in case of permanently dismissed students will be as per the following procedure:

"If a student who was awarded the punishment of permanent dismissal but was subsequently allowed relief under regulation 50 (3), wishes that he shall be given a clean record of conduct, may apply for the same after the completion of his degree. On receipt of such an application a committee would be constituted by the Academic Council on whose recommendation it would be decided as to whether or not the fact of permanent dismissal would be recorded on the outgoing transcript and if a satisfactory character certificate should be issued to him. This committee would be constituted in a meeting of the Academic Council and shall consist of 7 members of the Academic Council to be selected randomly either with the help of a computer or through table of random members. This committee may follow such procedure as it may deem necessary and may also consider the reports of the Advisor, Warden, Head of the Department and Dean of the College concerned or of any other person whose views the committee may deem relevant."

Students awarded the punishment of 'dismissal' may at the discretion of the Vice-chancellor, be readmitted after the expiry of the period of punishment on the recommendation of the Dean concerned and the Discipline Committee on such conditions as may be prescribed in this behalf. No student will, however, be entitled to re-admission as a matter of right.

52 1) Temporary Dismissal

The fact of punishment of temporary dismissal or suspended dismissal during the period of temporary dismissal shall be recorded on the permanent record card and shall be mentioned in the outgoing transcript until the punishment has been revoked and the student is re-admitted. It shall, however, not be mentioned in the outgoing transcript after readmission of the student. However, if any prospective employer or institution etc. request for details about the student concerned, the punishment awarded to the student shall normally be intimated to them only after obtaining the orders of the Vice-chancellor on the desirability or otherwise of giving such information to the party concerned.

Permanent Dismissal

The fact of punishment of permanent dismissal or suspended dismissal shall be recorded in the permanent record card and shall be mentioned in the outgoing transcript, unless the sub-committee to be constituted as per the procedure laid down under regulations 50(6) (c), recommended otherwise.

53 Issue of Character Certificate to various categories of students

- (1) Character Certificate with good conduct as well as the prescribed two-p. Character Certificate shall be issued to all students who are not punished at time during the period of their studentship as well as to those who are away the punishment of (1) Reprimand of record/warning, (2) Monetary fine a (3) Conduct Probation, provided the Conduct Probation has been removed at time of issuing the certificate.
- (2) The two-point Character Certificate shall not be issued to the following categories of students:
 - (i) All students awarded the punishment of permanent dismissal, rusticas or temporary dismissal for any length of time, even after the re-admission.
 - (ii) All students who were found guilty of using unfair means in examination at any time during their stay in the University.
 - (iii) Character Certificate with satisfactory conduct may be issued to a students who are awarded the punishment of temporary dismissal on once during period of their stay in the University if the same recommended by the Discipline Committee and approved by a Academic council.
- (3) Character Certificate with satisfactory conduct to the students who have bee awarded (1) punishment of temporary dismissal more than once or (2 punishment of permanent dismissal /rustication may be issued if they as allowed readmission under regulation 50 (3) only after the recommendation of the Committee constituted by the Academic Council as defined in the note for regulation under 50 (6) (c) of the regulations on Admission, Enrolment and continuance of students.



54 Refusal of Admission to students against whom cases in the Court/s were pending






ANTI RAGGING

Code of Conduct for Students

Henceforth, the students should follow the defined norms to maintain a learning environment that promulgates well-being of all stakeholders and uphold the dignity not only in the university but outside also.

- Every student should follow all regulations set by the university for different activities and maintain decorum by way of appropriate behaviour.
- Every student should pay respect to teachers and staff of the university.
- Their behaviour should uphold the values and reputation of the university.
- Every student should wear ribboned identity card every day while on campus.
- · Every student should be regular in classes, do their assignments timely, and read the notices displayed on notice boards and university website regularly.
- Every student should participate in various activities organized in the campus.
- The students participating in activities organized outside campus representing the university should strictly adhere to the norms of the host institution and should not indulge in any activity that defame the institution.
- Every student should read and follow the instructions for entry to the premises, use of library and other facilities for students.
- Every student should keep the premises clean and contribute in environment protection and plantation drives.
- Every student should switch off lights and fans not in use and close taps and other water outlets when not required.
- No offensive words or symbols should be written/drawn in black board, wall, online platforms (teaching and related activities) and such places.

- Every student should not indulge in any activity that is detrimental to safety of others.

All the students should abide by the rules/guidelines to ensure a healthy, friendly, innovative and collaborative learning environment. For any breach of rules/guidelines, the assigned committee shall look into the case and the student may be awarded punishment and suitable disciplinary action may be taken as per the provisions of Academic Regulations of the University. The punishment may be warning/restriction/expulsion/monitory penalty/suspension or ineligibility for readmission.

POLICY FOR GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL FOR THE STUDENTS OF SARDAR VALLABHBHAI PATEL UNIVERSITY OF AGRICULTURE AND TECHNOLOGY, MEERUT, UTTAR PRADESH

Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel University of Agriculture and Technology, Meerut is committed to provide a safe, fair and harmonious learning and working environment. Students are the main stakeholders and component of institutional framework of a university. All educational institutions imparting education with a motto to provide transparency for all student activities at different stages have a yeoman duty to hear student grievance at par. Pursuant to UGC Regulations, 2012 on Grievance Redressal, as notified in the Gazette of India, dated March 23, 2013, the university, hereby notifies Guidelines in broad conformity with the said Regulations of UGC, with an aim to address the grievances of students.

Definition of Grievance

A grievance shall include any discontent or dissatisfaction, whether expressed or not, whether valid or not, arising out of anything connected with the university that student thinks, believes, or feels, is unfair, unjust or inequitable. As regards the grievance of students the grievances defined in UGC regulations under clause 2 (f) of the gazette notification no. 14-4/2012 (CPP-II) dated December 2012 shall be included.


Objectives of Grievance Redressal

The objectives of grievance redressal will be to develop a responsive and accountable attitude among all the stakeholders in order to maintain a harmonious educational atmosphere in the university. A grievance cell will be constituted for redressal of the problems reported by the students with a following objectives: -

- Upholding the dignity of the university by ensuring strife free atmosphere in the campus through promoting cordial Student-Student and Student-Teacher relationship.
- Encouraging the Students to express their grievances / problems freely and frankly, without any fear of being victimized.
- Advising Students of the university to respect the right and dignity of one another and show utmost restraint and patience whenever any occasion of rift arises.
- Advising all students to refrain from inciting students against other students, teachers and university administration.
- Advising all staffs to be affectionate to the students and not behave in a vindictive manner towards any of them for any reason.
- Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited in and outside the University. Any violation of ragging and disciplinary rules should be urgently brought to the notice of the authorities.

Placements & Internships	On-campus or off-campus interviews, soft skills training, Internships, etc.
General administration	Collection of fees, on-line fee payment gateway, ID cards, Scholarships, HR related issues, Transportation, Ragging etc.
Other related issues	Safety & Security, Discipline, Misbehaviours, Emergency services, Physical/Mental/Sexual Harassment, Discrimination based on community disparities, Victimization by the teachers as well as other staff etc.

Grievance Redressal Cell

The function of this cell will be to investigate the complaints lodged by any student and judge its merits. Matters related to harassment will also take up by this cell. Any one with a genuine grievance may approach the any member of the cell. The grievance cell shall be required to furnish the answer within 10 working days of presentation of grievance.

 If the cell does not reply within stipulated period or the person is not satisfied with the decision of grievance redressal cell, he/she can prefer an appeal to the appellate authority of the university within a period of one week.

2. The grievance redressal cell shall have a tenure of two years.

 In case of any false or frivolous complaint, the cell may order appropriate action against the complainant.

Measures to address the Grievance: University shall follow the flowing measures to address the grievances.

- Open Door: General invitations to students in formally dropped in the concerned office
 and talk informally over their grievance. They may even present the grievance through
 official contact numbers of the concerned officer(s).
- Drop Boxes: Students can drop their complaints in the drop box placed at administrative block.
- Opinion Survey: Through mentor and other feedback schemes, the opinion surveys may be conducted for better understanding.
- E-mail: Through separate E-mail created for grievance purpose. grievances.svpuat@gmail.com
- Janhit Guarantee Adhiniyam: Students can also use this Govt. online portal for their grievances particularly related to the academic issues.

Note- All the grievances of students mentioned in this grievance policy documents will be governed as per the provisions made in Act & Statues, Academic regulation, Hostel rule book, VCI regulation, ICAR guidelines and UGC norms and Uttar Pradesh Shasan.
