Products from carrots, tomatoes and litchi can also be prepared. High-quality bakery products from cereals, pulses, and millets are also being produced. Revenue is being generated through the sale of processed products by the graduate students under the student ready programme. Training programs have been conducted for farmers, rural youths, and women, enhancing their skills in food processing and bakery production. Such modernized facilities contribute towards minimizing post-harvest losses of mangoes and other produce.
