**PROCEEDINGS OF EIGHTH MEETING OF ACADEMIC COUNCIL HELD IN  
COMMITTEE ROOM OF BIO - CONTROL LABORATORY AT 25 AUGUST, 2003**

The meeting started with welcome by Registrar / Secretary Academic Council to Hon'ble Vice - Chancellor / Chairman of Academic Council and new members of the Council. Following agenda were discussed and decisions were taken.

**Agenda I** Confirmation of minutes of VII<sup>th</sup> Meeting of Academic Council held on  
07 - 07 - 2003

Minutes were confirmed.

**Agenda II** Admission against vacant seats under B.Sc. Ag. degree programme (2003 - 04)

The issue was discussed and it was decided to fill up the vacant seats after last date of admission (08 - 7 - 03) under special case because of various reasons on part of the University. It was also decided that such admission shall only be made by the date so that the student/s admitted are able to attend at least 75% of classes during Ist Semester 2003 - 04. No further condonation for shortage in attendance will be given in any case to such students admitted.

After detailed discussion it was decided that vacant NRI seats may be converted to Paid Seats and Paid Seats may be converted to Normal Seats in case the candidates are not available for admission against NRI and Paid Seats, respectively.

**Agenda III** Admission to Under Graduate degree programme in College of Bio - Technology during 2003 - 04 Academic Session.

The Vice- Chancellor / Chairman of Academic Council proposed for admission to under graduate degree programme in College of Bio- Technology (2003 - 04 Academic Session ) as the college has been approved by U.P. Govt. and construction is under progress.

The proposal was discussed in detail and it was decided to admit the students to the under graduate degree programme w.e.f. 2003 - 04 Academic Session.

It was decided to run the classes for the session (2003 - 04) in class rooms available in old / new building of the university.

**The following decisions were also taken after discussion concerning the admission -**

The name of Under Graduate degree programme in College of Bio- Technology shall be Bachelor of Technology (Bio- Technology).

The duration for the degree programme shall be at least 4 years.

Normally, the admission to the programme shall be made in month of July every year.

The number of seats for admission to the programme in an academic session shall be as following -

Normal Seats	60 (for U.P. domicile candidates only)
Paid Seats	18 (Rs. 50,000 per candidates per year in addition to the normal dues, open to all Indian candidates from all provinces of India)
NRI Seats	2 * (Two thousand dollars or equivalent money per candidate per year in addition to the normal dues )

(\* If NRI candidates are not available for admission, the NRI seats may be converted to paid seats on the recommendation of Registrar and Dean of the College.)

The admission shall be made strictly on the basis of merit in Entrance Test for admission and reservation as per U.G. Govt. and the University rules.

The candidates who have passed or appeared in Intermediate (10 +2) Examination or equivalent with Science ( Biology or Mathematics or Bio- Math Group) or Agriculture shall be eligible to appear in the Entrance Test. However , no Entrance Test will be required for NRI candidates.

The number of seats for admission to the programme during academic session (2003 - 04) shall be as following -

Normal Seats	30
Paid Seats	10

The admission for academic session (2003 - 04) shall be made in January 2004 (i.e. IInd Semester 2003 - 04 )
