Agenda 1 - Confirmation of minutes of XVIIIth and XIXth meeting of AC held on December 31, 2004 and January 29, 2005, respectively.

Agenda II - Relaxation in cut of point in case of SC category for admission in M.Sc. (Ag.) for the session 05-06.

It was decided that cut of point in case of SC category be lowered from 45% to 40% since there were few students came up to that standard for admission.

Agenda III - With the permission of chair, Dr. Ashok Kumar proposed that UE seats in unreserved category be filled in by other seats since they were fallen vacant due to non availability of candidates upto that standard.

The proposal was turned down.

Agenda IV - With the permission of chair, Prof. Samsher Singh proposed that rules for admission for M.Tech. should also be worked out on with M.Sc. (Ag.) Programmes.

It was decided that admission in M.Tech. (2 Seats) shall be decided after adding two seats in 23 seats of M.Sc. (Ag.) (Total 25 seats) and then reservation rules be followed on 25 seats rather than 23 seats.
