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STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

The three Universities namely:

- (1) Narendra Deva Kirshi Evam Prodyogik Vishwavidyalaya, Faizabad
- (2) Chandra Shekhar Azad Kirshi Evam Prodyogik Vishwavidyalaya, Kanpur and
 - Sardar Vallabh Bhai Patel Kirshi Evam Prodyogik Vishwavidyalaya, Meerut Established under the Uttar Pradesh Kirshi Evam Prodyogik Vishwavidyalaya Adhiniyam, 1958 (U.P. Act no 45 of 1958) are conducting their entrance examinations separately for admission in their various course of study due to which the candidates seeking admission in Krishi Evam Prodyogik course of study have to fill admission form and deposit fee in each Vishwavidyalaya which causes unnecessary burden on the candidates. Besides, the candidates do not get proper information from every such Vishwavidyalaya timely. Therefore, in order to remove the said inconvenience to the candidates, it has been decided to amend the said Act to provide that the Registrar shall be responsible for organizing, by rotation, joint entrance examination in all course of study of the three State Agricultural Universities.

The Uttar Pradesh Kirshi Evam Prodyogik Vishwavidyalaya (Dwitiya Sanshodhan) Vidheyak, 2006 is introduced accordingly.

As per above provision the Sardar Vallabh Bhai Patel Kirshi Evam Prodyogik Vishwavidyalaya, Meerut would organise the Combined Entrance Examination – 2008 for admission.

- (i) B.Sc. (Ag.) Hons. / B.Tech. Biotechnology: Maximum age limit will be 22 years on 31.12.2008 (relaxable by 3 years for SC/ST/OBC candidates).
- (ii) No age limit in Post Graduate Programme.

Fee of Paid Seats (One time non-refundable):

In addition to above, they will also be required to pay all regular (Annual as well as Semester) dues as paid by those students who have been admitted on free seats.

Evaluation:

- (i) Three marks will be awarded for each correct answer.
- (ii) There shall be no negative marking.

Method of Selection:

The admission shall be made strictly in order of merit-cum-reservation based on the aggregate marks obtained by the candidate in the Entrance Examination-2008.

For Ph.D. programmes if the marks secured by two or more candidates are the same, the merit shall be decided on the basis of marks secured in the concerned subject then Statistics, General Study and their qualifying examination. For Master's programmes in the event of two or more candidates securing equal marks the merit shall be decided on the basis of marks secured in the General Study then Agronomy, Horticulture, Animal Husbandry and then qualifying examination. For Under Graduate programmes in the event of two or more candidates securing equal marks, the merit shall be decided on the basis of marks secured in General Study then Zoology, Chemistry and Botany thereafter in the qualifying examination. In the event of tie again, a candidate higher in age would be rated higher in merit.

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Qualifying Marks in Entrance Examination:

For all the programmes, the minimum qualifying marks in aggregate shall be 30% for General, OBC category and 20% for SC/ST category.

For BVSc & AH the minimum qualifying marks in aggregate shall be 50% for General & OBC Category and 40% for SC/ST category.

Legal Jurisdiction :

All disputes pertaining to the conduct of Entrance Examination and other issue related to Joint Entrance Examination conducted by the Sardar Vallabh Bhai Patel University of Agriculture & Technology, Meerut shall fall within the Jurisdiction of Meerut court only.

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The questions shall be framed from all subjects and the weight age given to each subject will be as per number of credits generally assigned to each subject as given below:

Agenda – 7 Proposal for changing the syllabus of Horticulture for Combined Entrance Examination Test- 2008.

The proposal was submitted by Head, Department of Horticulture, and the revised syllabus is given here under.

Horticulture (Revised)

Importance and scope of Horticulture, classification of horticulture crops, propagation studies, important aspects of fruit, vegetable & flower nurseries plant growing structures, plant growth regulators and their use in horticulture crops, Basics principles of orchard establishment and training & pruning, factors affecting vegetable production, types of vegetable cultivation, basic principles of vegetable & flower seed production. Styles of gardens & their parts, lawns, ornamental trees & seasonal flowering plants for various purposes, Indoor gardening, cultivation of important fruit, vegetable and flower crops, basic principles of fruit and vegetable preservation, post barvest management of fruit and vegetables, value addition and marketing of horticulture.

The above proposal was approved by the house unanimously.

Agenda – 8 Proposal for deletion of NSS course from the programme of Department of

Communication & Rural Development. This course will be taught at the University
level. A programme Coordinator at University level programme Officer at each college

The Proposal was submitted by Head, Department of Agricultural Biotech, for the approval of Academic Council to start Ph.D. (Biotech) programme from Academic Session 2008-09.

The proposal was discussed and approved with provision of intake of two students after minor correction on the issue of core/optional courses subject to approval of Dean PGS.

Agenda-11 Proposal for approval to start M.Tech. (Biotechnology) in College of Biotechnology.

The proposal was placed by the Faculty Secretary, College of Biotechnology. After discussion at length, the Academic Council approved it with a provision of twelve students intake with some minor modifications in the curriculum and courses followed by approval of Dean PGS.

- Agenda -12

 i) The chairman raised the issue of anomaly of nomenclature and scattered Biotechnology Programmes in the College of Biotechnology and College of Agriculture. The issue was discussed at length and it was agreed in principle that all Biotechnology Programmes should run under the College of Biotechnology. In order to resolve the issue, following decisions were taken:
 - a) To decide the process of merger of Department of Biotechnology of the College of Agriculture in the College of Biotechnology, a committee comprising of Dr Y. P. Singh, Dean, PGS as Chairman and Dr. B. Ram, Dean (Ag), Dr. Devi Singh, Dean (Biotech), Dr. Rajendra Kumar, HOD (Biotech.), Dr. Raghvendar Singh, HOD (Immunology) as members and Registrar as Member Secretary was constituted. The committee will find out the modalities of merger and submit its report to the Vice-Chancellor for administrative approval / order.
 - b) To resolve the issue of nomenclature of the Departments in the College of Biotechnology the previously constituted three member committee was expanded. It will now have Dr. R.P.Sharma, IARI, Chairman; Dr. P.K.Gupta, CCS University, Meerut; Dr. H.S.Dhaliwal, IIT Roorakee; Dr. Devi Singh, Dean (Biotech), Dr. Rajendra Kumar, HOD (Biotech), members and Registrar as Member Secretary.

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- (ii) Registrar submitted the issue of B.Sc. (Ag) I semester students for their late registration resulting in shortage of attendance. It was discussed thoroughly and approved as under.
 - a) Their attendance percentage should be counted on the basis of the total lectures/practical classes from their registration date onward to the last class lecture/practical.
 - b) They may be permitted for appearing in the final examinations as well as for the make up examinations as a special case only for this time which should not to be cited as an example in future.
- (iii) Qualification of Junior Agronomist in Rice improvement Project (ACRIP) Research Station, Nagina (Bijnore): Doctorate in Agronomy with NET qualified and with consistent good academic record; Desirable: Experience of working on rice research after M.Sc. (Ag.)/ Ph.D. degree.
