TRIALS FOR "Elocution contest"



One of the regular features of the ASC is the Student Elocution Contest. It consists of a two- tier process. The first round consists of selecting two students from each zone for which the country has been divided into six zones. Therefore University trials for "Zonal Contest" will be held as mentioned below:

Venue of trials: Conference Hall, College of Biotechnology

Date and time of trials: 17 August, 2023 at 3.00 pm onward.


Rules:

1. The theme of the elocution contest is "**Transformation of Agri-Food Systems for Achieving Sustainable Development Goals**". The contestants should attempt to put forth their view with reasons to support as to how Agricultural Education can play a role in Transformation of Agri-Food Systems for Achieving SDGs.
2. Each student will be given 10 minutes of time for a PowerPoint Presentation and 2-3 minutes to answer questions from the audience.
3. The language of elocution will be English.
4. The participants will be evaluated on the basis of language, content (introduction, review and scientific/supporting material) expression, audio-visuals, time coordination, question answer interactions and overall impact.
5. The first and the second prize winners of the Zonal Elocution competition shall be given Rs 10,000 and Rs 5000 each, respectively. In case there is a tie, the amount will be equally shared among the winners.
6. The first, second and third prize winners of the National Elocution competition shall be given cash prize of Rs 20,000, Rs 15,000 and Rs 10,000 each respectively with a certificate. In case there is a tie, the amount will be equally shared among the winners.
